### Race Entry Details

To participate in the Welsh Alpine Championships, British competitors must be registered with their Home Nation Governing Body (Snowsport Wales, England, Scotland or Northern Ireland) for the 2007 season.

All competitors must have a current insurance policy that permits them to participate in organised ski racing. The race committee may ask for proof of insurance.

The organising committee reserves the right to refuse entry from skiers who do not demonstrate a minimum level of competence. Entries from competitors with no prior race experience should be supported with a coach's letter of recommendation.

All entries must be made on the official race entry form, one per competitor, and accompanied by the correct entry fees.
